Questions for Small Groups:

1. We are to be "in the world" but not "of the world". In the everyday grind of life what does that lifestyle demand from us and how are you doing with these dual challenges?
2. Must we demand our own selfish desires of our personal cultures and friendships; from our families and relationships-- or are we called to not seek our own good, but the good of our neighbor. What does that look like at the office? In your extended family?
3. Are you giving your life and your desires for the good of others? If not why not?
4. How do you walk in daily communion with God and his people and live in a culture which demands moment to moment choices regarding navigating evil influences?
5. 3 things to think about:
 - Is what I am doing spiritually troubling to lost people?
 - Can I ask the blessing of the Lord on this action that I take?
 - Can I do this thing for the glory of God?
