1 Corinthians 15:12-45

This is a sermon on resurrection and the love of Christ for the people of Corinth ... in spite of their spiritual immaturity.

- 1. As we discuss the resurrection of the body please share how Christ, through His indwelling Spirit, has already begun a resurrection process in your life.
- 2. Do you, understandably, fear death (I suspect, in some sense we all do)? Does Paul's affirmation that you and he will rise and that "to be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord" comfort you?
- 3. Does knowing that you will live eternally and meet your maker help you to walk a little straighter and live a more purposeful life! How so!
- 4. The words "steadfast and immovable" speak to certain military qualities. Are you seeking the Lord to make you stronger in all your broken places?
- 5. Paul directed an offering be taken for poor Jewish people, particularly persecuted Jewish Christians in Jerusalem. In light of this sacrifice, made by the gentile people of Corinth, do you think it made for more peaceful and trusting relations between Jewish Christians and gentile Christians?
