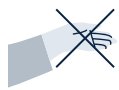


TKC Reopening Plan - Phase 1

In-Person Services at TKC will resume on May 31st, at 50% capacity with services at 9am and 11am. We are so excited to see you!

- Services will be 1 hour long, and childcare will not be offered. Children are always welcome in the service! (King's Kids lessons will be posted online)
- Midweek in-person meetings are still temporarily suspended

Promoting Social Distancing



We will **suspend meet and greet, paper bulletins** and **refreshments** portions of our service. You're welcome, introverts!



We will promote good hygiene through **hand-washing reminders, sanitizer stations, and modified Communion**



We will **thoroughly disinfect surfaces** such as doorknobs, tables, and surfaces before and between every service



We will **promote distancing** by widening our aisles, removing chairs, and increasing distance between rows.



We will **increase ventilation** by opening doors and windows and adjusting air conditioning

If you're unsure about returning to a church gathering so soon, **we will continue to offer our livestream at 9am and 11am every Sunday at live.thekingschapel.org**

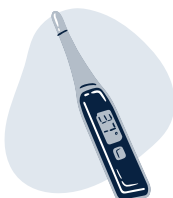
Join us for **live online worship and prayer** Wednesdays at 7pm
